In memoriam: Dr. George Karpati 1934-2009



Karpati was recognized internationally as one of the leading experts on the diagnosis and treatment of neuromuscular disorders. He worked as a professor in neurology at McGill University in Montreal, Canada. He made seminal contributions in the area of muscular dystrophy like the localisation of the dystrophin protein, the first research on gene therapy with

myoblast transfer and important work on myositis. With his death, we lose a great scientist who dedicated his life to finding a therapy for Duchenne muscular dystrophy. *Text: Prof. dr. M. de Visser*
